Scoping Opinion Request for Sand and Gravel Extraction.

Land off Bourbles Farm Preesall.

I refer to your consultation dated 15 June 2022 in respect of the above planning application.

Any application submitted on this matter should be accompanied with a Transport Statement (TS)

The TS would need to provide details on:

- traffic movements – daily movements broken down into vehicle types, covering site set up, operation and remediation
- impact on road safety (analysis of collision data)
- vehicle routeing
- vehicle tracking at site access and other junctions (A588)
- access strategy (why the choice of access has been made and why other options have not been considered – ie why not directly onto the A588)
- wheel cleaning on site.
- Impact on highway integrity due to poor highway conditions locally
